





### Rules and regulation of the Tóth Károly Study Scholarship

The purpose study scholarship is to provide financial support (in the form of a reduction of the cost of attendance) to students in years 2-5 of the English language programme who have achieved outstanding academic results and have demonstrated exemplary behaviour worthy of university citizenship. The scholarship is awarded through a competitive application process. One student per class can receive the scholarship. The applications received are evaluated by the Academic Committee and the Dean of the Faculty decides on the award of the scholarship on the basis of a proposal from the Academic Committee.

Duration of the scholarship: autumn and spring semesters of the following academic year Rate of the scholarship: 10% discount on the own cost of the 2 semesters

Application criteria:

- the applicant is following the model curriculum of the course (students repeating a course are not eligible to apply)
- the applicant has achieved a minimum weighted grade point average of 4.5 in both semesters of the current academic year
- the applicant has completed all the compulsory courses for the semesters in question
- the applicant has been an active student for both semesters
- no debts to the University of Szeged are outstanding at the time of application

In addition to the above, students' performance may also be assessed on the basis of their social, sporting and other activities.

In assessing the applications received:

- excluded condition is mandatory courses taken but not completed by the application deadline
- if the student has been the subject of a disciplinary decision

If the student's status is terminated or suspended, the scholarship will no longer be paid.

Application deadline: 15 July of each year

<u>Application method</u>: by submitting the completed application form (Annex 1) and the required attachments in person or by email to the Foreign Studies Department of the FOK by the deadline.







Evaluation of applications received: on the basis of the attached faculty scoring system (Annex 2)

The rules of operation of the Tóth Károly Study Scholarship were approved by the Faculty Council in its decision 2/2023 (2023.02.15) of 15.02.2023.
