APPLICATION TO THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE DENTAL MEDICINE PROGRAM

This regulation is for citizens, who are applying to the English language dental medicine program.

I. General entry requirements

- (1) Applicants are required to be over the age of 18 in the year of application.
- (2) Applications are accepted from graduates of accredited high schools or colleges/universities from abroad. According to the decision of the Admission Committee of the Faculty of Dentistry of the University of Szeged, students who have failed any subject in the final year of their high school studies, are not entitled to apply to our program.
- (3) Applicants are also eligible to complete their online application and sit for an entrance examination, if they are in their final year, but have not received the School Leaving Certificate or Diploma yet. In this case, the applicant must present proof that they are attending high school.
- (4) Applicants need to submit their application through the University's online Application System called Dream Apply.
- (5) Applicants are required to sit for an entrance examination.

II. Entrance examination

- (1) Entrance examinations are held in Hungary and abroad mainly online from the end of February until the middle of July, for the forthcoming academic year. Applicants are allowed to participate in maximum two examinations during one application period, if the chance is offered by the University of Szeged.
- (2) The exam consists of a written and an oral part. Topics of the written and oral examination include Biology, Chemistry and English Language Skills and are available the Faculty of Dentistry.
- (3) The oral part of the exam consists of an interview up to 20 minutes. The purpose of the oral part is to obtain the applicant's linguistic and professional competence in the natural sciences subjects being tested. The topics of the oral entrance examination can be found on the homepage of the Faculty.

III. Exemption from sitting for the entrance examination

(1) Holders of the following degrees can be exempted from sitting for the entrance examination:

- *International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma*: Students are required to achieve a grade 5 at least in two natural science subjects (Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Mathematics) and English language.
- General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE A-levels): Students are required to achieve a level of performance with grade A in English language and three natural science subjects (Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Mathematics).
- First *Class Honours Bachelor of Science (B.S.) Degree* in Natural, Biomedical, Life Sciences, Chemistry, Biology, Physics.
- *First Class Honours Bachelor of Science (B.S.) Degree* in Dental Hygiene for Dentistry program, if studies were pursued in English language.
- (2) The documents of the degrees are only accepted as attested copies in English language or as certificates with an authorized English translation.

IV. Decision

- (1) Following the entrance examination, decision on admission is made by the Dean of the Faculty of Dentistry based on the examination result and the suggestion of the examination committee.
- (2) Applicants who have already been admitted and who have paid the tuition fee, if the application is cancelled, are entitled to a refund of 80% of the tuition fee (of which 20% is a non-refundable deposit) after submitting a request for a refund and returning the completed refund form.
